**MetroList Services, Inc. is the First MLS in The Nation
To Achieve RESO's Highest Data Dictionary Certification**

MetroList is 100% 1.4 Data Dictionary Compliant and is Platinum Certified

Sacramento, California [September 8, 2015] - MetroList Services, Inc. (MetroList®) is once again at the forefront of setting the MLS industry data standards by becoming the first MLS in the nation to achieve Data Dictionary 1.4 Platinum Certification by The Real Estate Standards Organization (RESO). Two months ago, MetroList set the standard by becoming the first MLS to achieve Data Dictionary 1.3 Core Certification, the new industry standard that allows third-party vendors and services to access data from different MLS systems in a standard format without having to create a unique mapping for each MLS. The Platinum designation attests to an organization being 100% compliant.

"MetroList has set the standard of how important accurate data mapping is to the entire industry," said Jeremy Crawford, Executive Director of RESO. "We owe them a great debt of gratitude for going above and beyond the base requirements of certification as their entire team worked tirelessly to achieve platinum certification, the highest level of RESO certification."

RESO Data Dictionary Certification sets the highest industry standards for data collection and how that data is disseminated to real estate agents and brokers. The National Association of REALTORS® requires MLSs to be RESO Data Dictionary compliant by January 2016 through the RESO Certification Process. The RESO Data Dictionary Certification Process requires "Core" certification on either version 1.3 or 1.4 of the Data Dictionary. Platinum certification level requirement is currently scheduled for 2020 and an MLS will need to gain certification on the two most recent versions of the Data Dictionary. Data Dictionary Version 1.5 is scheduled for release in Q2 2016 and RESO plans on one version release per year.
